Accommodations

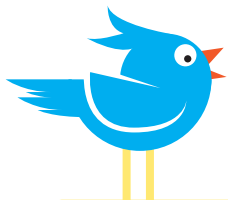

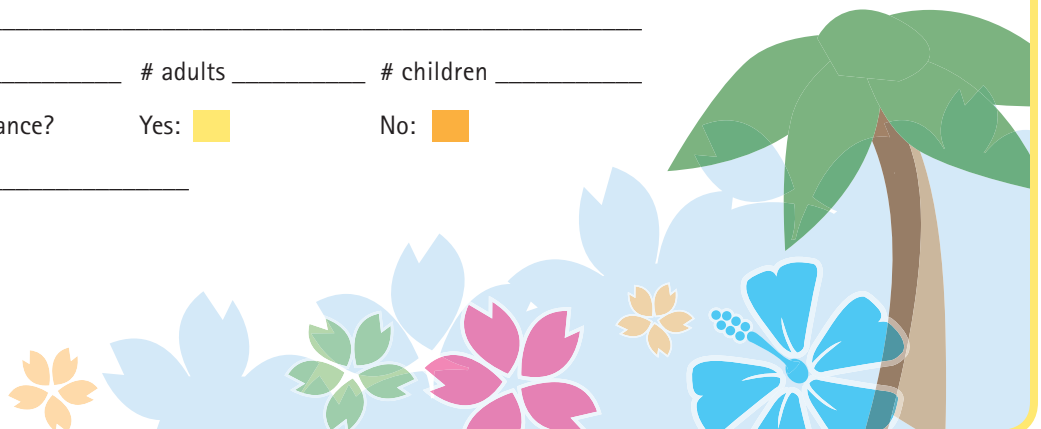
